We are pleased to share our 2024 election cycle political contributions report, which includes a list of candidates and political committees supported either by Pfizer Inc. or the Pfizer PAC, from January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2024.

We are proud our PAC is bipartisan and contributes to elected officials in both political parties who support policies that encourage innovation and put patients first. Pfizer continues its work to advance commonsense policies that focus on expanding patients' ability to access and afford their medicines.

In the 2024 cycle, the Pfizer PAC and Pfizer Inc. supported 1,553 candidates and multiple political committees from both sides of the aisle and at all levels of government. Fifty-six percent (56%) of the Pfizer PAC disbursements went to Republicans and forty-four percent (44%) went to Democrats. Our PAC support and corporate political contributions do not imply an endorsement of a candidate or an elected official's position on every issue.

We hope you will take some time to review our 2024 cycle, political contributions report. Together, our efforts can advance Pfizer's mission of Breakthroughs that Change Patients' Lives.

What is a PAC?

PAC stands for Political Action Committee. A political action committee is a government-regulated organization that anyone can form to raise money for political campaign donations. PACs are formed by individuals, non-profits, and even many major corporations.

How Does Pfizer PAC Work?

The Pfizer political action committee, Pfizer PAC, is a nonpartisan organization that provides opportunities for employees to participate in the American political process. The Pfizer PAC is an employee-run organization with a Steering Committee made up of Pfizer employees from different divisions of the company. All corporate PACs are funded by voluntary employee contributions. Pfizer PAC is no different; it relies on the participation of Pfizer colleagues.

Who Receives Pfizer PAC Contributions?

Pfizer PAC is nonpartisan. It supports Democrats and Republicans alike. From January 2023 through December 2024, Pfizer PAC supported 678 candidates. True to its nonpartisan values, Pfizer PAC is committed to support candidates from both political parties who share Pfizer's vision and values for healthcare. When choosing to make a contribution to a candidate, the Pfizer PAC considers the candidates' view on issues that impact Pfizer, our employees and the patients we serve. This includes policy priorities that support the development of and patient access to innovative medicines, manufacturing, a secure supply chain, patient affordability and intellectual property rights. We may also consider the presence of Pfizer facilities or employees in the candidates' district or state where the candidate is aligned on key priorities. A complete list of Pfizer PAC and state corporate political contributions for January 2023 - December 2024 is included in this report.



PFIZER PAC & POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS GOVERNANCE POLICY

Pfizer complies fully with all federal, state, and local laws and reporting requirements governing PAC and corporate political contributions.

Pfizer has a Corporate Policy Procedure that requires all PAC and corporate political contributions to be compiled and published annually in a report that is made available to employees, shareholders, and the public, and posted on the Company's website at www.pfizer.com. At the end of each Federal cycle (every two years), the Pfizer PAC is audited by Withum, a certified public accounting and advisory firm.

In 2023, Pfizer requested that trade associations receiving total payments of \$25,000 or more from Pfizer in a given year report the portion of Pfizer dues or payments used for expenditures or contributions that, if made directly by Pfizer, would not be deductible under section 162(e)(1)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code. Prior to 2023, we requested this information from trade associations receiving total payments of \$100,000 or more. We are disclosing such information received from our trade associations in this report.

Pfizer has a PAC Steering Committee comprised of nine colleagues who review and approve all PAC and corporate political contributions on a monthly basis. The PAC Steering Committee evaluates candidates on a basis of their views on issues that impact Pfizer and its colleagues. It also takes note of whether Pfizer facilities or colleagues reside in a candidate's district or state.

In 2010, Pfizer adopted a policy that prohibits the company from making direct independent expenditures, including direct contributions to 527 independent expenditure committees, a decision supported by the executives and affirmed by the Governance & Sustainability Committee of our Board. The PAC report also explains that Pfizer typically does not make contributions to 527 Issue Organizations. However, if requested to make such a contribution, it would undergo review and approval by the Political Contributions Policy Committee (PCPC). The 2023 -2024 PCPC, co-chaired by Pfizer's Chief Corporate Affairs Officer and the former Chief Compliance, Quality & Risk Officer, consists of senior leaders from various divisions. Any contributions made to 527 Issue Organizations would be disclosed in the PAC report.

Independent Auditor's Report

Opinion

We have audited the combined financial statements of Pfizer Inc. Political Action Committee, which comprise the combined statements of assets, liabilities and net assets arising from cash transactions - cash basis as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related combined statements of revenue, expenses and changes in net assets arising from cash transactions – cash basis for the years then ended, and the related notes to the combined financial statements - cash basis.

In our opinion, the accompanying combined financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the assets, liabilities, and net assets of the Pfizer Inc. Political Action Committee as if December 31, 2024 and 2023, and its revenue, expenses, and changes in net assets for the years then ended in accordance with the cash basis of accounting described in Note 2.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America ("GAAS"). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of Pfizer Inc. Political Action Committee and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audits. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to Note 2 of the financial statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements are prepared on the cash basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Our opinion is not modified with respect to that matter.

Responsibilities of Management for the Combined Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the cash basis of accounting, as described in Note 2, and for determining that the cash basis of accounting is an acceptable basis for the preparation of the financial statements in the circumstances. Management is also responsible for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.



Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Combined Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the combined financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with GAAS will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. 1. Committee Description

The Pfizer Inc. Political Action Committee (the “Committee”) was formed by Pfizer Inc. (the “Company”) to solicit and receive voluntary political contributions from employees and stockholders of the Company and certain subsidiaries to assist candidates for elective office. The Committee was registered with the Federal Election Commission in April 1976. During 2024 and 2023, contributions could be designated by the contributor to a specific candidate or political party for political office. Designated contributions are remitted directly to the candidate or political party by the Committee on behalf of the contributor. There were no such designated contributions in 2024 and 2023. Contributions to the Committee which are undesignated are subsequently designated by the Committee’s Steering Committee.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

a. Basis of Accounting

The combined financial statements of the Committee have been prepared using the cash basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Under this basis, revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned. Expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. The combined financial statements of the Committee include Pfizer Michigan Political Action Committee and Pfizer Missouri Political Action Committee, which were formed to comply with certain state laws.

b. Accounting Estimates

The preparation of combined financial statements requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reporting of assets, liabilities and contingencies, if any, at the date of the combined financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

c. Revenue and Expense Recognition

Contributions are recognized as revenue in the period cash is received or withheld from the Company’s payroll. Contributions to candidates at the discretion of the Committee are recognized when distributed. Interest income and bank charges are recognized when reported on the bank statement.

The Company pays all administrative salaries and benefits, legal fees, and other administrative fees on behalf of the Committee. These costs are not reflected in the accompanying combined statements of revenue, expenses, and changes in net assets arising from cash transactions.

d. Net Assets

Net assets are reported as with donor restriction if they arise from contributions received with donor stipulations on their use. When a donor restriction expires, that is, the purpose of the restriction is accomplished, net assets with restrictions are reclassified to net assets without restrictions and reported in the combined statements of revenue, expenses and changes in net assets arising from cash transactions as net assets released from restrictions. There were no net assets with donor restrictions held by the Committee at December 31, 2024 and 2023 or during the years then ended.

e. Functional Expenses

For the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, political expenses are shown as program expenses on the combined statements of revenue, expenses and changes in net assets arising from cash transactions. No costs have been allocated among program expenses.

f. Subsequent Events

In preparing these combined financial statements, management of the Committee has evaluated events and transactions that occurred after December 31, 2024 for potential disclosure in the combined financial statements. These events and transactions were evaluated through March 31, 2025, the date that the combined financial statements were available to be issued, and no items have come to the attention of management that require disclosure.

3. Information Regarding Liquidity and Availability

As of December 31, 2024 and 2023, the Committee has \$227,398 and \$281,252, respectively, of cash available to meet the cash needs for general expenditures within one year. None of the cash is subject to donor or other contractual restrictions that make it unavailable for general expenditures. As the Company pays the operating expenses of the Committee, the Committee generally uses cash collected to make political contributions.

4. Income Tax Status

The Committee is exempt from federal and state income taxes under Section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code and related state statutes, except for taxes on its investment income, which is taxed at the highest corporate tax rate.

Management of an organization is required to evaluate income tax positions taken and disclose an income tax liability if the organization has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the Internal Revenue Service. Management has evaluated the income tax positions taken by the Committee and concluded that as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, there are no uncertain positions taken or expected to be taken that would require disclosure of a liability in the combined financial statements. The Committee is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits in progress for any tax periods. In addition, there have been no tax related interest or penalties for the periods presented in these combined financial statements. Should such penalties and interest be incurred, the Committee's policy is to recognize them as operating expenses. Management believes the Committee is no longer subject to income tax examinations for years prior to 2021.

5. Related Party Transactions

The Company pays certain general administrative and overhead expenses on behalf of the Committee. These expenses are not reimbursed nor are they accounted for in these combined financial statements.

6. Concentrations

The Committee has significant cash balances at financial institutions which throughout the year regularly exceed the federally insured limit of \$250,000. Any loss incurred or a lack of access to such funds could have a significant adverse impact on the Committee's financial condition, results of operations, and cash flows.
