

Pfizer Joins Broad Effort to Observe National Disability Employment Awareness Month

Nationwide Campaign will take Place in October

New York, NY — Pfizer Inc. (PFE) announced its participation in National Disability Employment Awareness Month, an annual awareness campaign that takes place each October. The purpose of National Disability Employment Awareness Month is to educate about disability employment issues and celebrate the many and varied contributions of America's workers with disabilities. This year's theme is "My disability is one part of who I am."

Reflecting this year's theme, throughout the month, Pfizer will be engaging in a variety of activities to educate its colleagues on disability employment issues and its commitment to an inclusive work culture. These efforts include: a panel discussion of issues of interest to caregivers; the publication of a "disability journal" in which colleagues share stories of living or working with a disability or caring for a family member with a disability; and a unique recruiting workshop in which Pfizer will partner with disability advocacy nonprofit groups to raise awareness of the contributions people with disabilities make to the workforce.
